## St. Mary Magdalene Church, Longfield Up-date on the Church works



The first phases of the church works were completed just before Christmas. During this phase, the drainage system has been re-designed to take water well away from the walls of the church. Two large soakaways were created and the guttering around the church and hall was replaced.

The concrete drains around the base of the church on the south and east sides were re-lined. Inside the church, there was a considerable amount of damage to the internal rendering from years of damp. This required



hacking out to a considerable depth and then re-plastering layer-by-layer which took many weeks. The re-plastered areas were then painted with five coats of lime wash which is a traditional technique and will help protect against mould and damp in the future.

Many thanks go to Astral Ltd., our building contractor and Thomas Ford, the church architects who oversaw the work. The next phase will include re-painting the remaining areas of the church - likely to start in the spring once the walls have dried out.

During the first phase, we've been using the church hall for worship, putting into use the new screen which has enabled us to avoid printed service sheets. We also plan to upgrade the audio-visual capabilities of the main church ready for our return following this further period of lock-down.

We had hoped for a working party to clear and clean the church during January. This will now be scheduled once we get the all-clear, hopefully in mid-February.
