

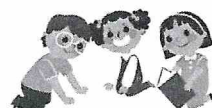

Pass our greetings to our friends over there.

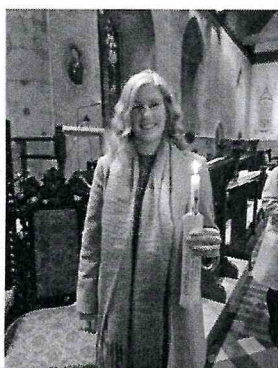
